PM Judge: David Wortham (DaWorth)

Evening Judge: Kelly Estes (Rhiannon's Rhapsody)

Location: Douglas County Fairgrounds, Castle Rock, Colorado (conveniently located just east of Interstate 25 midway between Colorado Springs and Denver—see directions below)

Fees: \$10 per animal per class, Showmanship is \$5 per entry. Showmanship is held in the morning show only. No refunds will be given after entries are received. A \$3 late fee will be charged per goat per class if postmarked after September 30, 2011. Mail entries to: Sally Jensen, 12035 Milam Road, Colorado Springs, CO 80908. Show Arrival: The barn will be available beginning at 5:00 pm on Friday, October 7th. Goats can stay there both Friday and Saturday nights. The barn must be vacated by 10:00 am on Sunday, October 9th.

Show Schedule: Check-in will begin at 7:45 am on Saturday October 8<sup>th</sup> and the AM show will start promptly at 9:00 am. The PM show will begin immediately after the AM show. The evening show will begin immediately after the PM show.

Animal Identification: All animals must have original NPGA registration papers. Any animal winning a Grand or Reserve Grand Championship must have a legible tattoo or microchip.

Pens: Pens will be available for your use. Pen charge will be \$3 for a 5X5 pen. Shavings will be available for purchase, or you may bring your own. No straw please! Local 4-H clubs will clean pens for \$5 per pen. Please note on the entry form if you would like your pens cleaned. The building housing your animals is temperature controlled.

Sick Animals: Any animal determined to be sick by the CoPGC or the contracted Judge must be withdrawn from the show. Refunds will not be given. Please **do not** bring sick animals to the show. Any animal that appears sick will need to be housed elsewhere.

Food: The CoPGC and the DC Cabritos 4-H club will have food, snacks, sodas and coffee for sale throughout the day. We will be hosting a Taco buffet for lunch; the charge for the Buffet will be \$5.00 per person.

Raffle: There will be a raffle table with lots of great items available. Raffle tickets will be sold for \$1 each. Donations of items to the table are much appreciated. All proceeds will go to support the club, show and prizes. We will also be having a Raffle drawing for a large item(s), we will send out information on this in a separate email. Tickets can be purchased in advanced or the day of the show. Details to follow.

Please remember that with THREE shows this will be a busy, full day, so:

- Please send in your entries on time so class sheets can be properly organized before the show.
- Double-check your class sheets to make sure your goats are in the right class (the show chair will also double-check). Remember that if you wish to participate in all three shows, the fee is \$10 x 3, or \$30 for all three shows. But you may show in any or all of the three shows.
- Please make sure that your goats are ready at the gate to expedite the show process.
- Have fun! We are all in this for the fun of showing our pygmies, so let's all meet and greet one another, help each other out and have a great time!

Other useful information: Motor homes and campers may also stay at the fairgrounds on Friday and Saturday nights **by prior arrangement**—please email or call Jane Boand for more information. Local hotels include Quality Inn, Day's Inn, Best Western Inn Suites, Super 8, Comfort Inn Suites and Hampton Inn.

Directions to the Douglas County Fairgrounds (500 Fairgrounds Dr. Castle Rock CO):

From the west on I-25--take I-25 Exit 181 (Plum Creek Parkway) and go east under the bridge. Continue approximately 0.3 miles east past Wilcox St and Perry St. to Fairgrounds Road. Turn left (north) on Fairgrounds Road (there is a traffic signal and a turn lane), and follow signs leading to the right (through Gate E) and then to the north side of the fairgrounds.

From the east--take SH 83 (Parker Road) to Lake Gulch Road. Turn west onto Lake Gulch Road, continue approximately 13 miles to Plum Creek Parkway. Turn left onto Plum Creek Parkway and continue approximately .5 miles to Fairgrounds Road (the second fair entrance), turn right into the Fairgrounds. Follow signs leading to the right (through Gate E) and then to the north side of the fairgrounds.

We will be in the multipurpose barn. Trailers may be unloaded at the barn, and free on-site parking is available just outside of the barn area.
